



Attachment-Based Assessment and Intervention: Using Play to Strengthen Family Bonds

June 13-14 8:30am-4pm

This is a 2 Day Training offered by Karen Buckwalter, LCSW, RPT-S which will be held from 8:30 AM - 4 PM over 2 Days with one hour for lunch (which will be provided onsite) and Two 15 minute breaks (one in the morning and one in the afternoon) each day. We expect to offer CEs and APT credits and are in the process of working through that process. The in-person, interactive workshop will include:

- Instruction about the Marschak Interaction Method (MIM) with an emphasis on providing parent feedback and effectively analyzing and using the MIM for treatment planning
- A brief overview of the Marital MIM
- Skills for using Video Intervention Therapy Techniques to enhance MIM parent feedback sessions
- The importance of exploring the parent's own history of being parented, ways to explore this history, and how to incorporate the parent's own history into the therapy process
- The intergenerational transmission of attachment and why therapists need to understand this process
- How the use of active play and the Theraplay Dimensions of Structure, Engagement, Nurture, and Challenge deepen parent-child relationships and reduce stress and conflict in families
- Adoption Specific Assessment and Ages and Stages in Adoption
- 7 Core Issues of Adoption
- Blocked Care What it is, how to alleviate it, and how it impacts attachment
- Wondering, Follow and Holding Practical Skills for Engaging Families

Participants may be given recommended readings to complete prior to the workshop to enhance learning. This workshop will be limited to 25 participants.
